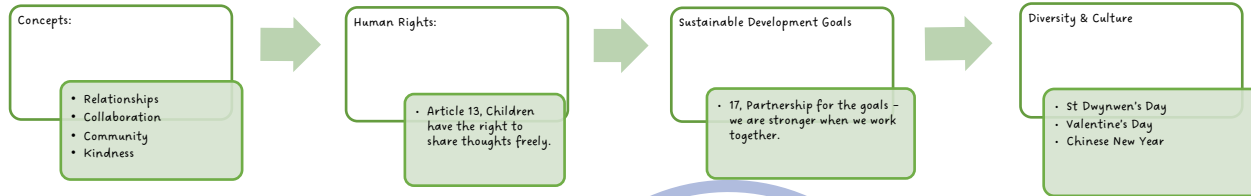


Healthy Body, Healthy Mind Terrific Teams
