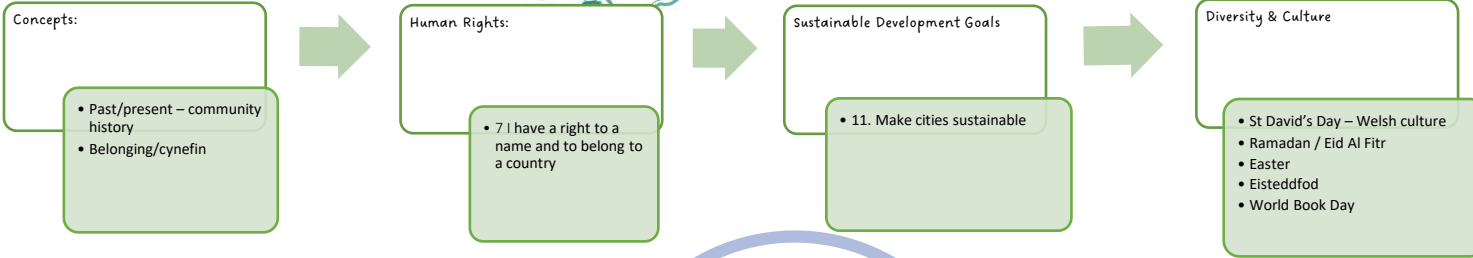


## Wonderful Wales

## Areas of Learning & Experience

### Literacy Language & Communication
